

Mrs. Missouri 2023 Hayden Dugger, a full-time police officer and a Beauty for Good ambassador since 2022, took some time to share her passion for saving lives from addiction.

Why did you choose to become a BFG ambassador?

I chose to become a BFG ambassador because I have witnessed firsthand the destruction drugs cause for the families and loved ones of addicts. As a full-time police officer, I often render aid and encouragement to those struggling with addiction.

I am also a child of an addict, and I remember being exposed to the drug environment as a child. I understand the importance of working to bring our drug epidemic to an end, and becoming a BFG ambassador was an additional way I could work towards creating better environments and lifestyles for others.

Do you have a connection to the foundation?

My life is affected almost daily by the drug epidemic. As a police officer, I remove harmful substances from within my community to keep people safe. I carry Narcan daily and have administered it during active overdoses. I have also witnessed the heartbreak of families who have lost their loved ones due to drug overdoses where Narcan was unavailable. I work to educate others on the warning signs of drug addiction, where to access Narcan, and how to effectively administer it to help save more lives. I mentor youth who come from troubled homes with drugs present and encourage them to have hope for a brighter future. My connection to the Victoria's Voice Foundation is that I have

connection to the Victoria's Voice Foundation is that I have witnessed firsthand the negative impacts that drugs and alcohol can leave behind. At the end of the day, every life matters, and we should strive to save them all and make our world a happy place.
